Yes, it's true. I am stepping away from pastoral leadership here at Northlake at the end of July less than a month after you read these words. This will be my final article as your pastor; *even saying that makes me wince!* Our hearts are heavy with the emotional weight of so many meaningful relationships here. Yet, we have a sense of peace that THIS is where God is leading: We're joining Melody and her husband, Jeremiah, in Temple as they begin the journey of marriage...and parenthood. (Having our first grandchild may have something to do with it.) They still have much

education ahead—Jeremiah graduates in May and Melody hopes to start P.A. school in January. Our intention is to help them build a good foundation in those early years of parenthood...and to hear those beloved words: *Papa John!* (I'm not sure what Tracy's moniker will be, but I'm putting money on "Nana").

We just celebrated seventeen years of ministry here at Northlake. *Seventeen*. While not a record for Northlake (by a longshot), it's my longest staff tenure—*by a factor of <u>three</u>*. The prospect of leaving this place, selling our house and being further from other family is hard to fathom...*not to mention uncertainty as to what's next for me vocationally and the fiscal concern that brings!* But this we know: God is leading, and He will continue providing—for YOU and for US. It will be *different*, but I think different is what Northlake needs right now, as it ministers to this community in today's culture. So, what I ask of you is threefold. 1) PRAY FOR US, that God reveals the entirety of His purpose for our future. 2) STAY THE COURSE, for Northlake needs your commitment, investment and encouragement. 3) KEEP THE FAITH, trusting that God knows what He's doing, even if we don't...*and greater things are yet to come as we work, watch and wait!* Tracy and I deeply love this church, and want only the best for what comes next. It has been an undeniable PRIVILEGE to serve you over these many years, even during the challenging days. For your love, support and missional partnership, we will forever be grateful.

The **Personnel Committee** is already hard at work, scheduling ministers to fill the pulpit until an INTERIM PASTOR is named (more on that in the coming weeks). The **Dallas Baptist Association** has been an <u>invaluable</u> resource for both my family and the church in this season of transition. I'm indebted to Ryan Jesperson and the entire DBA staff for their help, support, prayers and encouragement as we pursued the Lord's plan for our next steps. No matter WHO or WHAT the future holds, *God is already there*, so trust His HAND and follow His HEART. We'll be back from time to time, and you'll always be present in our minds and hearts. Thank you for all that you have meant to our family over the past 17 years. Words can't convey the depth of my gratitude.
