## THE PROMISE OF GOD'S STRENGTH Isaiah 40

In chapter 40, Isaiah speaks to a future generation. He shifts from addressing Judah facing the Assyrians in the  $8^{th}$  century BC to the Jewish exiles in Babylon in the  $6^{th}$  century BC. Isaiah shifts the primary theme of his message from confrontation to comfort. To those who are weary and tired, Isaiah shares a promise of God's strength.
